

Mystery Friend Project Regulations

Preamble

Mystery Friend is a project aimed at building a community of students and residents where everyone has the opportunity to develop, discover their talents, and work together towards social responsibility and reducing social barriers.

§1 General Provisions

1. The organizer of the Mystery Friend project is the Amicus Universitatis Nicolai Copernici Foundation, headquartered at Gagarina 11, 87-100 Toruń, NIP: 9562056743, REGON: 871550996, KRS: 0000027675, hereinafter referred to as the Organizer.
2. The co-organizer of the project is the Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń.
3. These regulations establish the general conditions between participants and the Organizer, where the subject is the provision of entertainment and educational services by the Organizer.

§2 Course and Implementation of Events

1. The Organizer conducts events within the project on a monthly basis.
2. The events are held on dates provided on the Organizer's website. Depending on the topic, events may take place outdoors or indoors, such as at the university or other units.
3. In exceptional cases, including the occurrence of force majeure, the Organizer reserves the right to change:
 - a) the location and time of the event,
 - b) the program and topics of the event,
 - c) the person leading the event.
4. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel scheduled classes, especially when:
 - a) the number of participants who have registered does not meet the minimum required for the event to take place,
 - b) weather conditions do not allow for the event,
 - c) other reasons beyond the Organizer's control.

§3 Registration and Participation Conditions

1. Participation in the event is free of charge.

2. Participants in events under the Mystery Friend project can be any adult, i.e., they must be 18 years old on the day of the event.
3. Conditions for participation in the events are:
 - a) registration through the form available on the designated website,
 - b) providing correct contact details,
 - c) receiving confirmation from the Organizer about being placed on the participants list via the email provided during registration.
4. Registration is conducted within the time frame specified by the Organizer until all spots are filled. Registration is carried out via an electronic form, the link to which can be found on the Organizer's website: fundacja.umk.pl/mystery-friend.
5. Every participant is required to be familiar with and comply with the provisions of the Regulations, actively participate in the event, which specifically means listening to the instructor and following their instructions, ensuring their own safety and health as well as that of other participants, complying with health and safety (H&S) and fire safety regulations, and adhering to the rules of social conduct in relation to other participants. In the event of inappropriate behavior or gross violation of social norms and generally accepted moral standards, the Organizer reserves the right to expel the participant from the event and refuse their registration for future events.

§4 Resignation from Participation

1. A participant may resign from the event by sending information to the Organizer's email address or by phone contact no later than 24 hours before the event.
2. In the event of a participant's absence from the event without prior notice of their absence, the Organizer reserves the right to reject the participant's registration for future events.

§5 Final Provisions

1. Information on the processing of personal data can be found on the website: fundacja.umk.pl/mystery-friend.
2. By filling out and submitting the registration form, the participant confirms they have read and accepted the Regulations and are aware of the rules for the processing of personal data by the Organizer.
3. In justified cases, the Organizer reserves the right to amend the Regulations, provided it does not worsen the participants' situation. Any amendments will be announced on the Organizer's website (fundacja.umk.pl/mystery-friend).

4. In the event of restrictions, orders, or bans introduced due to the occurrence of epidemics, the introduction of an epidemic threat, epidemic status, etc., the Organizer will contact participants with proposals for further activities.

5. These Regulations enter into force on October 14, 2024.
